Consider submitting a poster related to nursing education or an evidence-based clinical study with implications for nursing education. This conference is designed specifically for nurse educators with a special focus on active learning and assessment. Abstracts will be peer-reviewed and notification of acceptance will occur by July 20.

### Poster Guidelines:

Submit a 2-3 paragraph abstract that consists of:

- \* Title
- \* Author(s) Names, Emails, Cell Phone, Work Phone, School Name and Address
- \* Summary of strategy, project or study methodology
- \* Limitations/Conclusions/**References**
- \* Implications for nursing educational practice

Submit your poster abstract at <http://nursetim.com/nutsandbolts/> no later than July 15th, 2018.

Prepare your poster to stand alone on an easel (which we'll provide).

Presenters are expected to be available for questions and discussion with participants during posted exhibit/poster session hours. Handouts and your contact information are recommended for attendees but not required. Of the posters submitted, some will be selected for oral presentation.

Your presentation should be related to nursing education, although clinical studies that advance the art or science of evidence-based nursing will be considered. Of special interest are abstracts that address innovative teaching strategies, special learning needs of nursing students, creative clinical experiences, student success strategies, clinical simulation, pharmacology teaching ideas, and online learning. Abstracts will be peer-reviewed.
